The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 58 dated 25.01.2022 registered under Sections 120-B, 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that upon the directions of this Court dated 14.03.2022, the petitioner has not been able to join investigation and further submits that he is unable to contact the petitioner and prays for one more opportunity for the same.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has not joined the investigation from last two dates of hearing i.e. 26.07.2022 and 14.11.2022 and is misusing the interim relief granted by this Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

In view of the fact that on the last date of hearing also i.e. 14.11.2022, one opportunity was granted to the petitioner to join

investigation but it seems that petitioner is taking undue liberty of the interim relief granted by this Court and is not interested in joining the investigation.

In view of the above, interim protection granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.03.2022 stands vacated and present petition stands dismissed.
