This petition has been filed praying for issuance of direction to the official respondents to get vacated portion of the public road, canal watercourse and Khasra No.157//18/2/2 (0-18) as shown in the site plan (Annexure P-2) from the unauthorized occupation/encroachment of respondent No.8 which she has illegally encroached upon in connivance with respondent No.8. Further prayer has been made directing respondents No.1 and 2 to take appropriate action against the delinquent officers/officials in whose connivance the abovesaid public road and watercourse has been encroached upon by respondent No.8.

Notice was issued and reply was filed by learned State counsel.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the grievances of the petitioner have been redressed as the land encroached upon as prayed in this petition, has already been vacated. He has drawn the attention of this Court to the reply filed wherein Sub Divisional Engineer, Construction Sub Division, B&R, Br. Rampura Phul has informed to the respondent and Tehsildar Rampura Phul vide its letter No.2290 dated 17.09.2021 that the land was got vacated by the Firm of respondent No.8. It is also submitted in the reply that petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Land Act, 1961 was also been filed in the Court of DDPO, Bathinda.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, it is apparent that the grievances raised by the petitioners have been redressed, so, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail his remedies for the redressal of grievance if any remains.
