VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement and incorporate the entries of Fardbardar No.5 shown in the remarks Column No.8 of Jamabandi for the year 2010-11 & 2015-16 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively in Column No.7 of jamabandi for the year 2020-21 and remove the words fardbardar No.5 from the remarks Column No.8 for the jamabandi year 2020-2021 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Rajinder Singh, Kanungo, has submitted that the jamabandi for the year 2020-21 has been prepared and in column No.8, special remark has been made in consonance

with the prayer of the petitioner and has further stated that in the jamabandi for the year 2024-25, the said faradbardar No.5 would be reflected in column No.7 and would be removed from column No.8. Mr. Rajinder Singh, Kanungo who is present in Court today, has undertaken before this Court that the necessary entry would be made in column No.7 in the jamabandi for the year 2024-25.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the abovesaid statement made by learned State Counsel and by the Kanungo who is present in Court today, the present Civil Writ petition has been rendered infructuous and has prayed that the same may kindly be disposed of as such. It is however prayed that the State as well as the Kanungo, who is present in Court, be bound by the abovesaid statement.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. The State as well as the Kanungo, who is present in Court, would be bound by the abovesaid statement.
