Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.188 dated 25.09.2020 registered under Sections 420 IPC and 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion, the only consideration before this Court, submitted by the counsel for the petitioner was that the petitioner is ready to settle the dispute with the complainant. Thereafter, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre at Gurdaspur.

As per the report submitted by the Mediator, the petitioner never appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre despite affording the opportunity.

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court be directed to decide the regular bail application of the petitioner expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and apply for regular bail, the trial Court will dispose of the regular bail application of the petitioner within a period of 03 days thereafter.
