The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members as they apprehends eminent threats at the hands of the private respondents.

Pursuant to the notice a short reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rural, Gurdaspur.

Learned State counsel submits that an inquiry has been conducted by the SHO Police Station Dhariwal, Gurdaspur. Nothing has come on record to show that the respondent No.4 has threatened the present petitioner and his family members.

However, learned State counsel has assured the Court that in case, any complaint is received from the petitioner with regard of threat to his life and liberty, an appropriate and necessary action shall be taken in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, nothing survives with the present petition and is accordingly disposed off.
