AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

Mr. Satinder Khanna, Advocate for the appellants has placed on record consent letter and no objection letter signed by all the legal heirs including proforma respondents to say that let the compensation, if enhanced, be released in favour of appellant No.1-Renu Jagota wd/o Kuldarash Rai Jagota. The documents are taken on record as Mark-A and Mark-B respectively. He has also placed on record authority letter signed by the legal heirs permitting him to settle the dispute, to make any statement and get the compensation amount released in case it is enhanced in favour of appellant No.1-Renu Jagota wd/o Kuldarash Rai Jagota.

After making calculations, both the parties agreed that this appeal can be settled in case an amount of Rs.6,01,000/- is paid over and above the amount already paid by learned MACT. Both the parties have signed the settlement form in the Court.

In view of above facts, the appeal stands disposed of and it is ordered that an amount of Rs.6,01,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs One Thousand Only) be disbursed in favour of appellant No.1-Renu Jagota wd/o Kuldarash Rai Jagota

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of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order.
