The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 439 Cr.P.C., has been invoked for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 224, dated 15.10.2020, under Sections 148, 323, 341, 302, 427, 201 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the allegation against the petitioner is that he gave a danda blow on the face of Talwant Singh. He further submits that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and the co-accused of the petitioner namely Kuldeep Singh, Jashan Randhawa, Mandeep Singh and Jasbir Singh have already been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court vide orders dated 12.01.2023, 06.02.2023 and 17.02.2023 passed in CRM-M-17973-2022, CRM-M-31094-2022, CRM-M-4930-2023 and CRM-M-7519-2023 respectively.

Learned State counsel has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner, which is taken on record. According to which the petitioner has suffered incarceration for a period of 2 years 5 months and 25 months as of now and is not involved in any other case of any nature.

Considering the custody period undergone by the petitioner and the fact that the co-accused have already been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court added with the fact that challan stands presented wherein conclusion of trial shall take sufficient long time and nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

However, it is made clear that anything stated hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
