1. The petitioner, on attaining the age of superannuation, retired on 11.11.2005. He has filed a writ petition to direct the respondents to revise his retiral benefits, by incorporating the benefits of annual increments which were stopped, with or without cumulative effect. The petitioner has disclosed that the following orders were passed against him while punishing the petitioner:-
