Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to comply with directions issued by respondent No.3 vide his letter dated 13.06.2019 to respondent No.4 for restoration of the possession of the petitioner over the land in dispute qua his share. Further for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to hold an enquiry and take appropriate legal action against the erring officials, who had not complied with the directions issued vide letter dated 13.06.2019 issued by respondent No.3.

It has been mentioned in the petition that in compliance of letter dated 13.06.2019, the official respondents have not taken any action. Notice had been issued to the State and reply had been filed.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.9 has submitted before this Court that the grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed by the respondents. He has invited the attention of

this Court to the reply filed by respondent No.9-Nachhatter Singh wherein, it has been mentioned that the action has been taken on the letter dated 13.06.2019. It is submitted that in pursuance to letter dated 13.06.2019, as per the revenue record, grievances of the petitioner has been redressed as the possession has been restored and correction of the revenue record has been carried out accordingly and thus, nothing more survives for the adjudication of this case.

Learned State counsel has also submitted before this Court that grievance of the petitioner has been redressed.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, petitioner would be at liberty to pursue his remedies if so advised as in accordance with law.
