This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to take appropriate action on the complaint dated 07.12.2022 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.2 against respondent No.4 with respect to alleged misappropriation of panchayat funds.

Learned State Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, 5 and 6, on instructions from Sahab Singh, BDPO, Indri, has submitted that in pursuance of the complaint, an inquiry has been marked vide order dated 27.02.2023 to the SDO, Indri, District Karnal and after the inquiry is completed, in case, any illegality is found to have been committed then

action, in accordance with law, would be taken after following the due procedure.
