Matter was taken up on 12.01.2023, when learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant sought time for arguments.

2. Petition was admitted for hearing on 14.02.1994.
3. When taken up for final adjudication, after around 29 years, learned counsel appearing on behalf of appellant is unable to assist the Court for lack of instructions. Learned counsel for the appellant states that despite attempts, his office could not contact the appellant. **Even the address of the appellant is also perhaps not complete as is borne out from the memo of parties.** In the premise, no useful purpose would be served to issue fresh notice to the appellant as the same too would be an exercise in futile.
