The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.04 dated 18.01.2023 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

By virtue of the order dated 01.03.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
