ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

1. The correctness of concurrent findings of fact arrived at by the courts below is assailed by the defendant (State of Punjab) in this second appeal.

2. The respondent's one year service was forfeited with permanent effect by the Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar for 22 days absence. Subsequently, his leave was sanctioned. Thus, both the courts have concluded that because the absence stands regularized, there is no reason to uphold the order of punishment. Moreover, in the departmental inquiry, the necessary documents were not supplied to the respondent. In any case, the respondent was enrolled as a Constable on 07.06.1977. In normal course, the respondent must have retired on attaining the age of superannuation.

3. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

4. Dismissed.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
