ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Status report on behalf of the State has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Based on the status report, it has been argued that the present petition is not maintainable because the alleged detenue were arrested in accordance with law for commission of offence of non-bailable offence and more-so under Section 306 IPC. However the petitioner's counsel submits that the police had not produced the persons within 24 hours before the concerned Magistrate and beyond that time the detention was illegal.

State counsel contradicts the above contention made by counsel for the petitioner and submits that the alleged detenue were produced before the concerned Magistrate well within the time frame.

Petition is disposed of accordingly. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
