1. Prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside notice dated 29.10.2019 (Annexure P-1) under Section 13 (2) and notice dated 04.02.2020 (Annexure P-2) under Section 13 (4) of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (for short 'SARFAESI Act') and to stay the operation thereof.

2. Learned counsel for respondents, on instructions from Chief Manager, Central Bank of India, Panipat, submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioner's account has been settled and closed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not have any instructions in this regard.
