1. Appellant No. 1-Registrar, G.J.U, Hisar in person and respondent No. 2, Mr. Anoop Malik, Joint Registrar is also present in person.

2. Affidavit of Sh. Anoop Singh Malik, Joint Director (Local Audit), Haryana, Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology, Hisar, dated 09.08.2023, has been filed in Court today, stating the benefit of one increment on account of higher responsibilities has been granted to respondent No. 1 on 01.06.2023.

3. In the affidavit it has been averred that keeping in view the controversy as such, which we had also noticed on an earlier occasion, the said benefit be treated as a personal measure and not be treated as

precedent.

4. Keeping in view the fact that the matter arises out of contempt petition bearing No. COCP-2831-2022, which was arising out of CWP-11573-2022, whereby directions were issued to decide the representation within a specified period, the learned Single Judge in contempt had called the respondents to come present as to why they should not be punished in accordance with law.

5. Now, the compliance having been made, we are of the considered opinion that the present appeal has been rendered infructuous since the directions having been duly complied with.

6. It has been further brought to our notice that the original contempt petition bearing COCP-2831-2022 has already been disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, on account of the request made by learned counsel for the original writ petitioner Meera Bhola on 27.04.2023.

7. Keeping in view the above, the present appeal is also disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

8. Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, also stand disposed of.
