Prayer in the application for addition of Section 81 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 (for short, 'the Act') in the head note as well as prayer clause.

Notice to the non-applicant.

Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. AG, Haryana appearing on advance notice accepts the same. He has no objection to the acceptance of the prayer of the applicant.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Amended head note and prayer clause annexed with the application is taken on record.

Main petition

This is a petition seeking interim bail of four weeks in FIR No. 5 dated 8.1.2022, under Sections 370(5) and 34 IPC and Section 81 of the Act for performing last rites of the son of the petitioner.

Reply filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.

Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. AG, Punjab on instructions from

ASI-Geeta confirms the factum of death of petitioner's son on 10.2.2023.

For the reasons mentioned in the petition, the same is allowed.

The petitioner is granted two weeks interim bail on furnishing of bail bonds/surety bond to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The petitioner will surrender back to the jail authorities immediate after completion of two weeks.
