The correctness of an interlocutory order passed by the trial Court while permitting the plaintiffs to produce Dr. Inderjit Singh (handwriting and fingerprint exper) for cross-examination, has been challenged in this revision petition.

The learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the cross-examination of the aforesaid handwriting and fingerprint expert has already been completed.

At this stage, the learned counsel representing the parties have come to a consensus. It is agreed that the defendant will also be granted an opportunity to lead expert evidence after the plaintiffs are permitted to lead such evidence.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is disposed of while directing the trial Court to grant an opportunity to the defendants to lead expert evidence.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
