The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.1132 dated 23.12.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Panipat City, Panipat.

Status report by way of affidavit of Sandeep Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Traffic, Panipat dated 26.03.2023 filed in Court is taken on record.

By virtue of the order dated 13.03.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dharmender, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 13.03.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
