NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The appellant has filed the instant appeal against judgment and decree dated 12.09.1991 whereby learned Addl. District Judge, Amritsar while reversing the judgment and decree dated 26.09.1987 passed by the Trial Court, allowed the appeal filed by the respondent No.1/plaintiff.

Learned counsel for the appellant-Trust has produced a copy of letter dated 27.04.2021 regarding allotment of Booth Sites No.8, 9 and 21 area respectively 22.68 square yard, 97 Acres (Ajnala Road), Block D, Amritsar, to the respondent No.1/plaintiff.
