ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

This is appellant-plaintiffs' second appeal against the judgment of reversal. The trial Court decreed the suit for permanent injunction filed by the plaintiffs, but lower appellate Court reversed the judgment and decree of the trial Court and accordingly, dismissed the suit of plaintiffs and appellants-plaintiffs have, therefore, filed the present regular second appeal in this Court.

2. Appeal was admitted on 19.10.1993. While admitting the appeal, status quo with regard to possession was ordered to be maintained by the parties.

3. When taken up for final adjudication, learned counsel for the appellants is unable to assist the Court for lack of instructions. Learned counsel for the appellants states that despite repeated attempts, her office could not contact the appellants.

4. It seems that by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the appeal for more than 29 years before this Court, either it has been rendered infructuous or else the appellants seem to have lost interest in pursuing the same.
5. Be that as it may, appeal is dismissed with liberty to the appellants to file an appropriate application in case any cause of action still survives.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
