NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners and also directing respondent Nos.4 to 10 not to harass/interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali (respondent No.2) to consider and decide the representation dated 24.02.2023 (Annexure P-6) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection for their lives and personal liberty.

Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.
