The matter was taken up on 10.01.2023 when none appeared for either side. Registry was asked to issue fresh notice to the parties. Office report reveals that service has been fully effected. But, during the pendency of the appeal, both the appellants as well as respondents have died. However, LR's have not come forward to take any steps to get them impleaded.

At this stage, Mr. Sumit, Advocate appears and states that the case was filed by Mr. Sanjay Majithia, learned counsel who has now been designated as Senior Advocate and thus, he has no instructions to appear, but, he is appearing only as a matter of professional courtesy from his law office. When asked to argue the case, he expresses lack of instructions and apprises the Court that he does not have power of attorney and more so, he has not been able to contact the appellants.

Dismissed in default.
