**HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)**

Through this second petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.378 dated 17.10.2021, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind, Haryana, under Sections 302, 342, 201 and 120-B IPC.

Status report dated 26.04.2023 by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective Jind, District Jind, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is a lady, has falsely been implicated in the present case; that the petitioner was not named in the FIR, but has been indicted on the disclosure statement of co-accused, Jajwinder Singh @ Jass; that the petitioner has been in custody since 19.10.2021, and that out of 20 prosecution witnesses, only 02 witnesses have been examined so far. It is further submitted that the petitioner has a marriageable daughter and that

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there is no other case pending or registered against the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, while opposing the grant of bail to the petitioner, submits that though the petitioner has been indicted in the present case on the disclosure statement of the co-accused, yet the fact remains that she had actively participated in the commission of offence and that by hatching a criminal conspiracy, she alongwith co-accused had committed the murder of one Prince Pal. It is further submitted that the prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Indisputably, the petitioner was not named in the FIR, rather she has been indicted on the disclosure statement of the co-accused. The only allegation against the petitioner is that she alongwith the co-accused had hatched conspiracy to murder Prince Pal. She has been in custody since 19.10.2021. The prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined. Trial is unlikely to conclude any time soon. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
