Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.175 dated 10.05.2022 registered under Section 406, 408, 420, 477-A of the IPC (subsequently added Section 120-B of the IPC) registered at Police Station City Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Virender Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ellenabad, District Sirsa has been filed on behalf of respondent-State. Same is taken on record.

It is conceded by learned State counsel that petitioner has since joined the investigation. In view of the same and having regard to the factual position noticed earlier on 10.03.2023, the petition is allowed and the order dated 10.03.2023 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation

as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
