This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.118 dated 10.08.2021, registered at Police Station, Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 186, 509, 506 IPC and Section 3(1)(x) of SC & ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 02.03.2023, report dated 29.03.2023 has been received from the Addl. Sessions Judge, SBS Nagar, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any threat, pressure or coercion.
