Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the Clause 4 of the result-cum-order dated 26.08.2022 (Annexure P-11) to the extent that the petitioner has been excluded in the revised result being non-petitioner candidate in SLP No. 25184-25214 of 2018 titled as 'HSSC Vs. Priyanka and Ors.'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that being eligible, the petitioner had applied for the post of the Post Graduate Teacher (PGT) Chemistry in BCB Category in terms of Advt. No.04/2015 (Cat. No.2); that the petitioner had participated in the selection process; that the final result was declared on 27.12.2018; that in compliance of the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP No. 25184-25214 of 2018, the respondent-Department revised the final result on 07.01.2022, and the roll number of the petitioner had also figured therein; that the petitioner along with other candidates was called for scrutiny of documents on 31.01.2022; that the name of the petitioner was also recommended for the appointment to the post of

PGT (Chemistry) and that thereafter, the result was revised by respondent No.3, wherein the name of the petitioner did not figure due to the reason that he was not one of the petitioners in the SLP.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before respondent No.3-Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, by way of filing a representation dated 27.08.2022 (Annexure P-12), which is still pending consideration. It is further submitted that the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. R.S. Budhwar, Addl. AG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that he has no objection in case, the directions for deciding the representation aforesaid, are issued.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.3-Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, is directed to decide the representation dated 27.08.2022 (Annexure P-12) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, in accordance with law.
