Short reply by way of an affidavit dated 18.05.2023 of Shri Ranjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Nawanshahr, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 is already on file as per which necessary inquiry was conducted. The statements of the petitioners were recorded wherein they stated that they do not have any need for further police security. As per the report, protection is still being monitored through PCR. Now petitioners are residing at Mohalla Chopra, Nawanshahr along with their children for the last four months.

Separate reply has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.5, 6, 8 to 11.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that private respondents are still threatening the petitioners as per the instructions received by him from the petitioners.
