The petitioners have filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct the official respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted representations (Annexures P-8 and P-9) to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar and he shall be satisfied in case an appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.5 to look into their representations (Annexures P-8 and P-9).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 and 5, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 & 5.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.5 – Station

House Officer, Police Station, Rama Mandi, Jalandhar, to look into the matter and take appropriate action as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.
