The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.72 dated 17.01.2023 registered under Sections 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1) and quashing of impugned order dated 06.12.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by the trial Court whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits the matter has already been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant and the complaint filed by the complainant bearing No.NACT-311-2022 has already been withdrawn by him vide order dated 02.01.2023 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Sirsa. The petitioner has also been granted anticipatory bail in the above-said FIR vide order dated 10.03.2023 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Sirsa.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the fact that the matter has been compromised and the main complaint case has already been withdrawn by the complainant, the present petition is allowed and impugned order dated 06.12.2022 (Annexure P-2) declaring the petitioner as proclaimed person, FIR No.72 dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are ordered to be quashed.
