1. The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.413 dated 08.08.2018 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 201 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari, Haryana.

2. On 02.03.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* relies on the grant of anticipatory bail to similarly placed co-accused Bijender, Unas, Abdul Karim Khan, Jhadmal, Juver Khan, Ajij, Tahir and Ibrahim who had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M No.6135 of 2019 – Bijender Vs. State of Haryana, CRM-M No.8196 of 2019 – Unas & Anr. Vs. State of Haryana, CRM-M No.11232 of 2019 – Jhadmal & Anr. Vs. State of Haryana, CRM-M No.10635 of 2019 – Ajij Vs. State of Haryana, CRM-M No.21336 of 2019 – Tahir Vs. State of Haryana and CRM-M No.25205 of 2019 – Ibrahim Vs. State of Haryana, respectively.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Viney Phogat, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 02.05.2023.

Before the adjourned date, the State shall file a status report.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioners' joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.413 dated 08.08.2018 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 201 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari, they shall be released on *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

3. Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined and cooperated with the investigation and that their custodial interrogation is not required by the State.
4. After considering the submissions made on behalf of the petitioners as have been recorded in the afore-quoted order and the statement made on behalf of the State as also for the reason that similarly placed persons in identical matters being CRM-M No.6135 of 2019 – Bijender Vs. State of Haryana, CRM-M-8196 of 2019 – Unas and another vs. State of Haryana, CRM-M-11232 of 2019 – Jhadmal and another vs. State of Haryana, CRM-M-10635 of 2019 – Ajij vs. State of Haryana, CRM-M-21336 of 2019 – Tahir vs. State of Haryana and CRM-M-25205 of 2019 – Ibrahim vs. State of Haryana and another, have already been granted anticipatory bail, subject to the petitioner abiding by the conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C., the order of this Court dated 02.03.2023, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is ordered to be made absolute
