The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to conduct fair and proper investigation in case bearing FIR No. 201 dated 07.11.2019 under Section 304-A/279/337/338/201 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, by handing over the same to Special Investigation Team, Crime Branch.

On 14.02.2023, the following order was passed:-

“This petition is filed seeking directions to respondents Nos.1 to 4 to conduct fair and proper investigation in case bearing FIR No.201 dated 07.11.2019 under Section 304-A, 279, 337, 338, 201 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, by handing over the same to Special Investigation Team, Crime Branch.

Learned State counsel submitted that the investigation has been completed; challan presented and the charges have been framed and case is now fixed for hearing on 15.02.2023 for prosecution evidence. He further submitted that in view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner seeks an adjournment to get the instructions.

Adjourned to 17.02.2023.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take all the pleas as has been raised in the present petition before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
