The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.66 dated 09.03.2022 registered under Sections 379-A, 34 IPC and later on added Section 411 IPC at Police Station Sector-50, Gurugram.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.03.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 13.05.2023 by way of an affidavit of Sanjeev Balhara, Assistant Commissioner of Police Sadar, Gurugram has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Parkash admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 02.03.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
