Despite the case having been called out twice, learned counsel for the petitioner has not turned up.

Last opportunity is granted to the petitioner to do the needful, failing which the Court will have no option but to proceed in the matter and decide the same accordingly.”

that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter any further.
