1. This is an application for impleadment of LR's of appellant No.3-
Hazari, who is stated to have died, copy of his death certificate is there
on the record.
2. Notice of the application.
3. At this stage, Mr. Bhanu Sharma, Advocate accepts notice on behalf
of the non-applicant/respondent and is having no objection if the
application filed for impleading the LR's of applicant is allowed.

4. In view of the above, the application is allowed and Anil Kumar (son) is ordered to be impleaded as LR of deceased-Hazari for the purpose of disposal of main appeal, subject to all just exceptions.
5. Amended memo of parties is ordered to be taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Main Appeal

1. The counsel for the appellants submits that the matter stands compromised between the parties and compromise deed (Annexure A-1) is bearing signatures / thump impressions of all the parties and that the suit filed by the respondents/plaintiffs is to be disposed of in terms of compromise deed (Annexure A-1).
2. Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents/plaintiffs has also admitted the factum of compromise deed (Annexure A-1) and is having no objection if the suit filed by the respondents/plaintiffs is disposed of in terms of compromise deed (Annexure A-1) and the application moved by the appellants under Order 23 Rule 3 CPC is allowed in the aforesaid terms.
3. In the light of aforesaid statements, made by counsel for the parties, suit filed by the respondents/plaintiffs is disposed of in terms of compromise deed (Annexure A-1). Resultantly, present appeal also stands disposed of in the same terms.
