The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed with a prayer directing the private respondents No.4 to 10 not to harass or interfere in the personal life of the petitioner.

It was noted in the interim order dated 28.04.2017 that the private respondents No.4 to 10 who are the parents and other close/immediate relatives of the petitioner are forcing her to marry against her wishes and the petitioner wants to marry elsewhere.

As per order dated 11.05.2017, it was noted that the petitioner duly identified by ASI-Sunita Devi, Police Station Rania, Tehsil Rania, District Sirsa was present in Court and she claimed herself to be major and submitted that she was pressurized and forced to suffer the previous statements in FIR No.147 dated 12.05.2016 registered under Section 323/324/34 IPC and Section 12 of the Protection of Children From Sexual Offences Act.

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Even on 16.01.2019, 04.11.2019, 24.01.2020 and 01.05.2023, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

State counsel has informed that the accused in FIR No.147 dated 12.05.2016, registered under Section 323/324/34 IPC and Section 12 of the Protection of Children From Sexual Offences Act has already been acquitted.

The petitioner seems to have lost interest in the present litigation resulting into his non-appearance, as such, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
