Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.33 dated 3.2.2023 registered under Sections 420 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation.

Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that the petitioner who was not named in the FIR, has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of previous order of interim bail.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjeet Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and

further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 2.3.2023 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
