The grievance of the petitioners in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 4 to 9, not to harass the petitioners and for a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court Mr. Arun Gupta, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners prays that he will be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 and 3 to decide the representation dated 26.02.2023, moved by the petitioners, which is annexed as Annexure P-1 with this petition.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali and respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Mataur, District Mohali, to decide the representation dated 26.02.2023 (Annexure P-1)

within a period of 30 days from the receipt of certified copy of this order, qua the life and liberty of the petitioners and if any threat perception is found, take appropriate steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case or subscribe to the averments and allegations levelled in the petition against the respondent.
