The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 19.12.2022, passed by this Court in CWP-29121-2022, vide which, while issuing notice of motion, it was directed that coercive steps pursuant to impugned order dated 29.11.2022 shall be held in abeyance.

As per compliance affidavit, filed by the Income Tax Officer, Ward-2(4), Udyog Vihar, Gurugram, which is on record, after giving brief facts of the case, it is stated that the order of the writ Court was received on 06.01.2023 and thereafter, the respondent has withdrawn the attachment order as well as accounts have been de-attached, subject to final outcome of the writ petition.
