Three connected writ petitions have come up for the final disposal. The petitioners pray for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to grant all the benefits to the petitioners as already extended to the similarly situated employees of the Board.

The learned counsel representing respondent no.1 and 2 submits that the petitioners' services were not confirmed as they failed to pass the test of Punjabi language of Matriculation level within the prescribed time

period. However, now all the petitioners have passed the test of Punjabi language of Matriculation level and they have been confirmed by the concerned authority. He draws the attention of the Court to the order passed in the case of Onkar Chand, petitioner in Civil Writ Petition No.5756 of 2020. He further submits that the petitioners in remaining two petitions have also been granted similar relief.

Keeping in view the aforesaid development, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of accordingly.

However, since the learned counsel representing the petitioner(s) is not present when the case was called for hearing, he shall have the liberty to file an application, if any other grievance remains for redressal.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
