The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to respondents to release the electricity connection at the premises of the petitioner at Plot No.46, Khasra No.140, 142 Min, Amritsar Urban, Hide Market, G.T. Road, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1 as well as learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 submit that there is no necessity of filing any separate reply on behalf of said respondents.

A short reply on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 has been filed today in the Court which is taken on record wherein it has been

averred that the present petition has been rendered infructuous since electricity connection has already been released to the premises of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a situation to controvert the aforesaid statement made in the short reply.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition in case the aforesaid averment made in the short reply filed on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5, is found to be incorrect.
