The petitioners herein seek a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to enroll their services on the roll of Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited, Haryana, as per instructions dated 21.09.2021 and 14.04.2022 (Annexures P-7 and P-8 respectively) as they were working as Sweepers with the Municipal Council, Thanesar, District Kurukshetra since many years through Outsourcing Policy Part-I under various contractors.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners would submit that in this regard, the petitioners have approached the authorities concerned number of time, but to no avail. They have also served a detailed representation dated 05.02.2023 upon respondent No.2, but no action has been taken thereon till date. Counsel would submit that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied in case the said representation is decided by

passing a speaking order in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Appearance has also been caused by Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Advocate, on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6.

Let adequate number of copies of the writ petition be supplied to the respective counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents during the course of the day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-District Municipal Commissioner, Kurukshetra to decide representation dated 05.02.2023 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioners. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Employees Welfare Fund.
