By way of present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India challenge has been made to an Award dated 10.01.2020 passed by the reference Court-cum-Additional District Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali, whereby, reference No.110 of 25.07.2016 initiated at the instance of petitioner invoking Section 3H(4) of National Highway Act, 1956 was decided against him.

2. Learned counsel for private respondents refers to an order dated 17.02.2020 passed in civil suit titled as *Jaswinder Singh Versus Gurmeet Singh, INDIG 04-2015* (Annexure R-7/4) to contend that declaration challenging the sale deeds of the private respondents, already stands dismissed for non-prosecution.

3. Moreover, as per learned counsel for the petitioner, the landowner-petitioner has not approached him for the past almost 2 years and thus, he is not in a position to pursue the present writ petition on behalf of the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the petitioner does not appear to be interested in pursuing the present writ petition, the same is thus ordered to be dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioner to seek restoration in case, any cause survives in his favour.
