The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel inter alia submits that the petitioner is complainant in case bearing FIR No.216 dated 24.09.2022 under Sections 323, 325, 387, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural-I, and the private respondents, who are named in the abovesaid FIR, had been roaming freely and extending threats to the petitioner to effect a compromise with them. It has been further submitted that representation (Annexure P-4) dated 17.02.2023 was also made to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, however, it had proved to be in vain.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Ramdeep Pratap Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural to look into the representation (Annexure P-4) dated 17.02.2023 and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioner is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.
