Present application has been filed for placing on record the annual statement of account of the deceased Narender Singh as Annexure P-7.

Application is allowed and annual statement of account of the deceased is taken on record as Annexure P-7.

1. In the present petition, the claim of the petitioners is that after the death of Narender Singh i.e. husband of petitioner No. 1 and father of petitioner No. 2, petitioner No. 2 is entitled for compassionate appointment as well as ex-gratia financial benefits under the 2019 Rules, which benefits are not being extended to the petitioners and that too without any valid justification, hence, the respondents are liable to be

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directed to consider the claim of the petitioners and grant the benefit for which the petitioners are entitled for under the 2019 Rules qua the financial benefits as well as compassionate appointment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 02.11.2022 (Annexure P-6) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, the representation dated 02.11.2022 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
