DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No. 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, restricts his prayer to the effect that representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner submitted to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib-respondent No. 2 be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion restricted to respondent Nos. 1 to 3, only at this stage.

Mr. P.S. Grewal, DAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and states that he has no objection if the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted.

In view of the above and with the consent of both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, to decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-3) after taking into consideration all the relevants

aspects of it, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
