Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 214 dated 14.12.2017, under Sections 306 and 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala.

On 02.03.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 214 dated 14.12.2017, registered under Sections 306 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel submits that though the petitioners were named in the FIR, but during investigation, they were found innocent and were placed in column No.2 in the final report filed under

Section 173(8) Cr.PC before the Court. The deceased committed suicide due to some matrimonial dispute. On an application moved by the prosecution/ complainant under Section 319 CrPC., the petitioners have been summoned. He further submits that co-accused Gurnam Singh, father of the petitioners, have already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court.

Notice of motion for 11.04.2023.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Manipal Singh Atwal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and Mr. Prashant Bansal, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the complainant.

Meanwhile, in case, the petitioners surrender before the trial Court on or before 15.3.2023, they shall be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail/ surety bonds to its satisfaction.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of aforesaid order, the petitioner surrendered before the trial Court and has been granted bail.

Learned State counsel affirms that aforesaid factum.

In view of the above, order dated 02.03.2023 is hereby made absolute, subject to compliance of conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) CrPC.
