Petitioner has approached this Court praying for grant of protection to his life and liberty and family members and friends with further prayer to direct respondent No.3 not to intrude into his privacy.

Notice was issued in this case by this Court on 01.03.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, has apprised this Court that there was an FIR between the parties i.e. FIR No.365 dated 25.11.2017, under Sections 323, 368, 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (54 of 1959), at Police Station Central, Sector-17, Chandigarh. He has submitted that thereafter, both the parties have entered into the compromise and on the basis of compromise arrived at between them, this FIR is quashed by this Court vide order dated 27.02.2023 passed in CRM-M-35527-2021. He submits that in view of the same, no threat as alleged survives.

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After hearing counsel for the State and perusing the record, it is apparent that bone of contention between the parties was the pendency of the FIR which has been quashed by this Court vide order dated 27.02.2023 passed in CRM-M-35527-2021 on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties. In view of the same, no further order is required to be passed in this case and thus, the present petition is disposed of. However, petitioner would be at liberty to file representation to the concerned authorities in case any exigency so arrived.
