Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail pending trial to petitioner in FIR No.258 dated 18.09.2021, under Section 21 (29 added later on) of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Parao, Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

(2) Concededly bail application of the petitioner was declined by learned trial Court way back on 27.12.2021. As such, a period of approximately 2 years has gone by; therefore, without going into merits of the application, this Court deems it appropriate to relegate him before learned trial Court to take recourse to the remedy for seeking bail pending trial.

(3) Learned trial Court is requested that in case the application is moved within one week, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law, expeditiously.

(4) Disposed off with the above observation.
