DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking protection of their lives and personal liberty, from private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that both the petitioners are major, aged 20 years and 20 years respectively, however petitioner No. 2 is not of marriagable age, and are staying in "*live in relationship*". In support thereof, copy of affidavit and copy of aadhar Card pertaining to the petitioners (Annexures P-1 and P-2) have also been appended.

It is further submitted that a representation dated 27.02.2023 (Annexure P-3) has also been sent by the petitioners to the respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Karnal, which has not been taken into consideration, in spite of being threatened by private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Pursuant to supply of advance copy of petition, Mr. Bhupender Singh, DAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection if appropriate directions are given for deciding the representation submitted by the petitioners.

As petitioner No. 2 is not of marriageable age, therefore, without ex-

any opinion thereon, the petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Karnal to look into the grievances of the petitioners as set out in the petition and also expressed in the representation (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate action for protection of their lives and liberty as may be warranted by the circumstances, in accordance with law.

The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Karnal, for requisite compliance.

The petition is disposed of.
